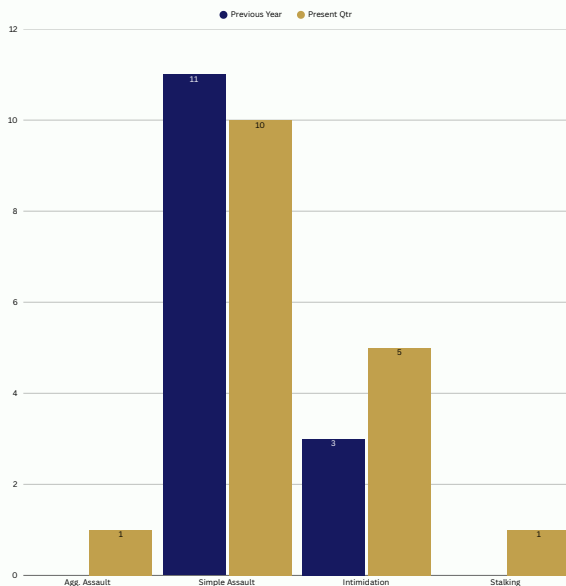

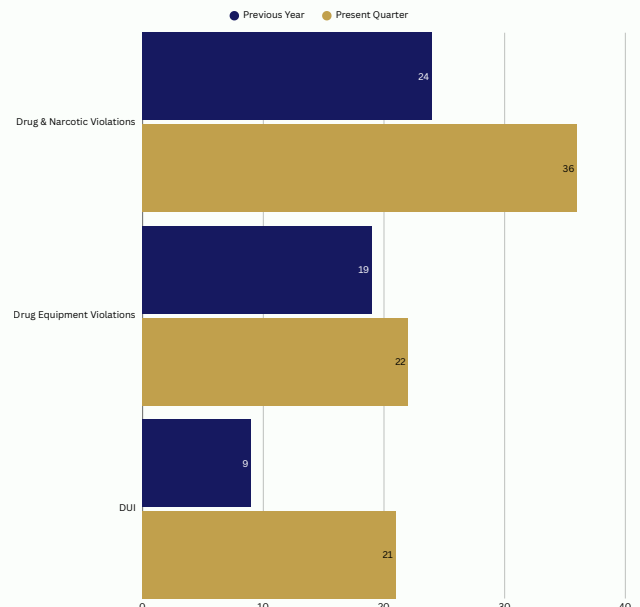

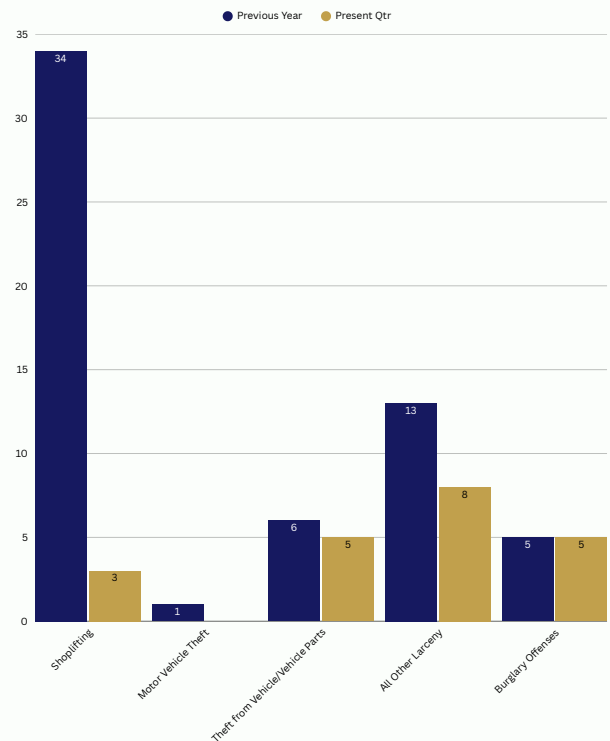

We are proud of Sgt. Parker's work and grateful for the opportunity to invest in the next generation of Collegedale students.

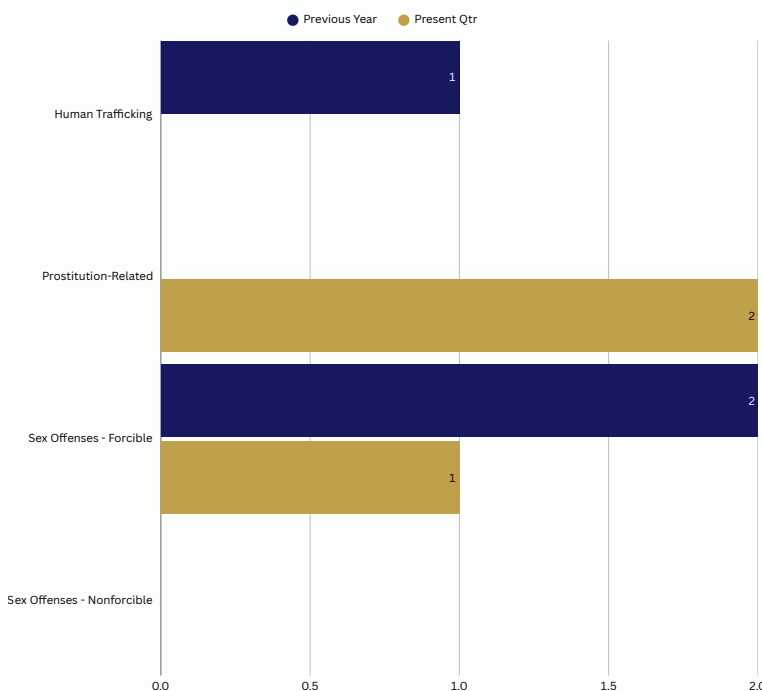

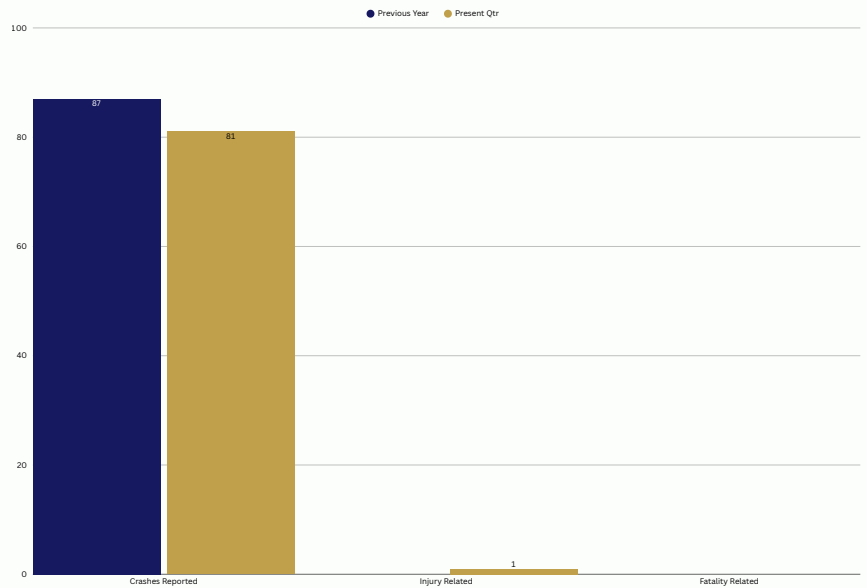

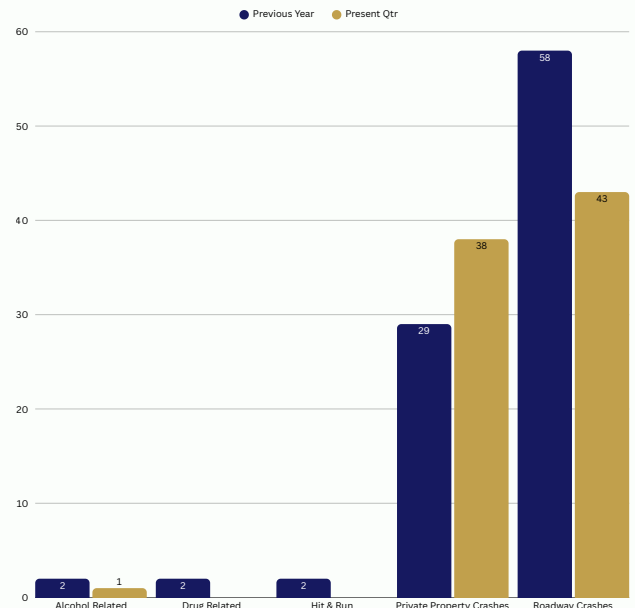

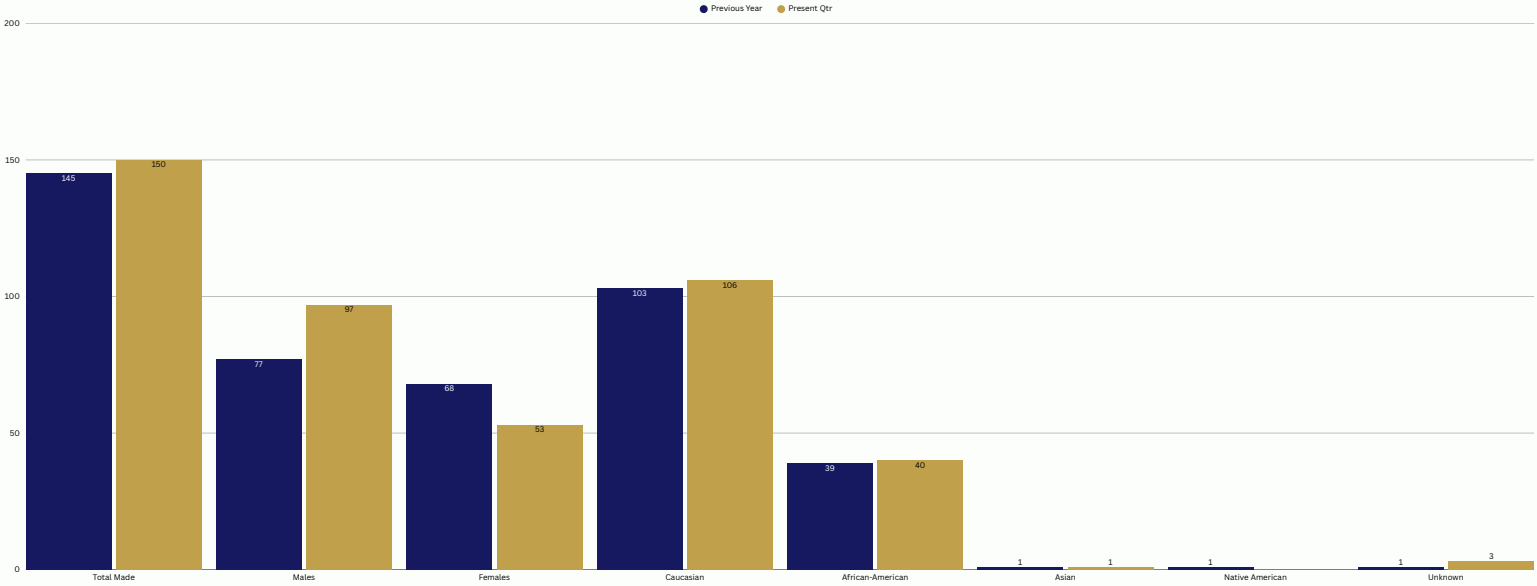

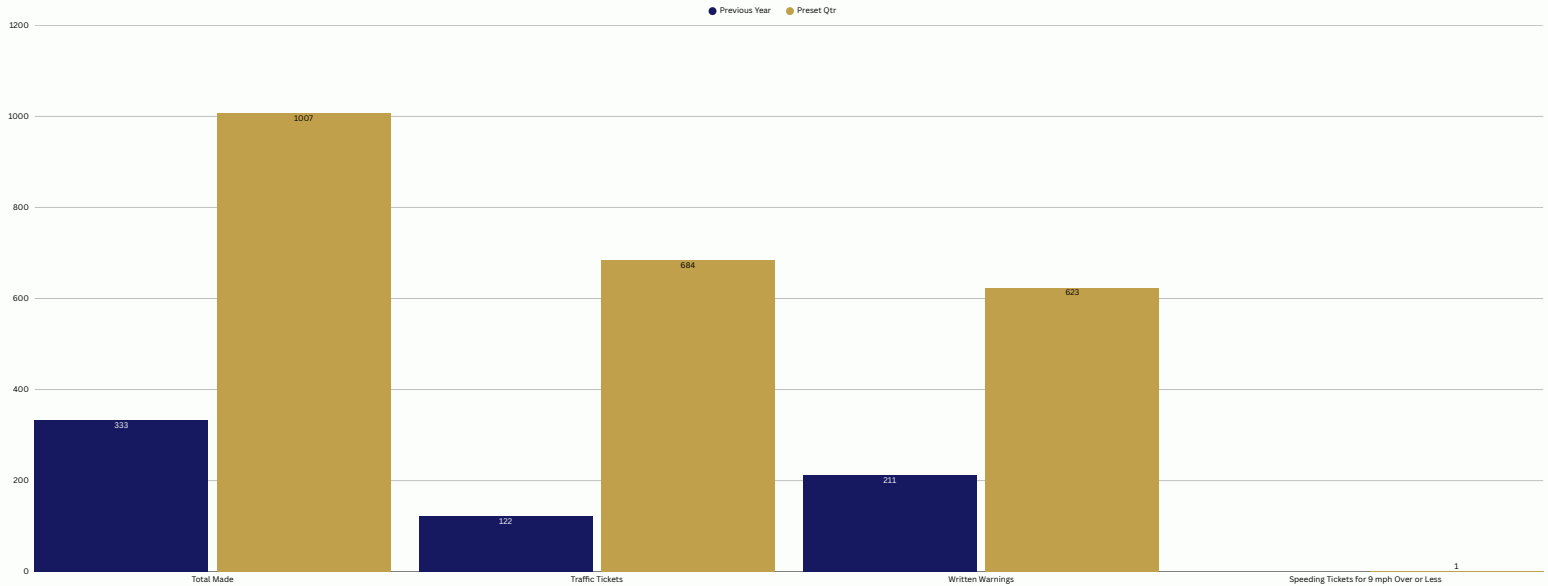
